Santa is on his way!

Christmas is only round the corner and it can be a very busy time for all so it is very easy to forget things on the run up to Christmas. Therefore, it is very important you check when your prescriptions will be due over the Christmas period, to ensure you leave enough time for the script to be signed and processed. All requests can take up to 2 working days for a doctor to sign and send the medication to the chemist who can then take on average 7 days to dispense medication.

If you are going away then please take this into account as well, please note down the dates you are away from and till on the request so the doctor can see why you are requesting earlier than normal and ensure you have enough medication to last during your holiday.



If you are unsure when to order your medication, please speak to the admin team.

You can request your medication at reception where you will find some medication request slips; on the NHS app or via our online consultation (PACO GP) via on our website (scan the QR code).

HPV (Human Papillomavirus) Vaccination

The Human Papillomavirus (or HPV vaccination as it is more commonly known) is a vaccine which helps reduces a persons chances of getting human papillomavirus (HPV). HPV is a common virus which is spread through skin contact and most types are harmless however, there are some types which are linked to an increased risk of certain types of cancer, such as;

 Cervical Cancer/Mouth Cancer/Anal Cancer/ Penile Cancer/Vulval Cancer/Vaginal Cancer

The HPV vaccine is recommended for children aged 12-13 years old as well as people at a higher risk from HPV. The vaccine is usually given at school however, if you have missed the vaccine you might be eligible to have this in the surgery.
